Tree Trimming

On Thursday, March 17, Johnson Tree Service will have a crew of 10-12 workers in our Novela neighborhood to trim the oak trees which also might include some branch removal. Prior to the upcoming tree trimming, they have asked that anything placed directly under trimmable tree canopies, such as vehicles and statuary, be temporarily relocated in advance for crew safety and damage prevention. The contractor cannot move these items and cannot be responsible for damage to anything remaining in the work zone. We recommend covering any lighting or irrigation that cannot be relocated.
